


### Pastor's Corner

In Philippians 2:14-15, Paul says "14 - Do everything without complaining or arguing, 15 - so that you may become blameless and pure, children of God without fault in a crooked and depraved generation, in which you shine like stars in the universe". The question is, are we going to whine or shine? It also reminded me of one of my favorite children's sermons that I ever heard, and it was about Mr. Grumbledump.
